Методические рекомендации для подготовки к Международному конкурсу Финансового университета для выпускников старшей школы иностранных государств по английскому языку

Предлагаемый на олимпиаде тест ПО английскому языку требованиям **B2** (upper-intermediate) соответствует уровня ПО европейской шкале (Common European языковой компетенции Framework).

Тест по английскому языку состоит из следующих разделов:

Раздел 1. Аудирование (10 тестовых заданий, 5 заданий на определение правильности или неправильности высказывания и 5 заданий на соответствие высказываний предложенным утверждениям)

Раздел 2. Чтение (10 тестовых заданий со множественным ответом)

Раздел 3. Лексика (15 тестовых заданий со множественным ответом)

Раздел 4. Грамматика (15 тестовых заданий со множественным ответом)

Тест предлагается на бумажном носителе. На выполнение работы даётся 90 минут. Тест оценивается в 100 баллов. За 1 ошибку в разделах «Аудирование», «Чтение», «Лексика» и «Грамматика» у участника олимпиады снимается 2 балла.

Раздел «Аудирование» включает в себя 10 тестовых заданий из которых 5 заданий на определение правильности или неправильности высказывания и 5 заданий на соответствие высказываний предложенным утверждениям.
